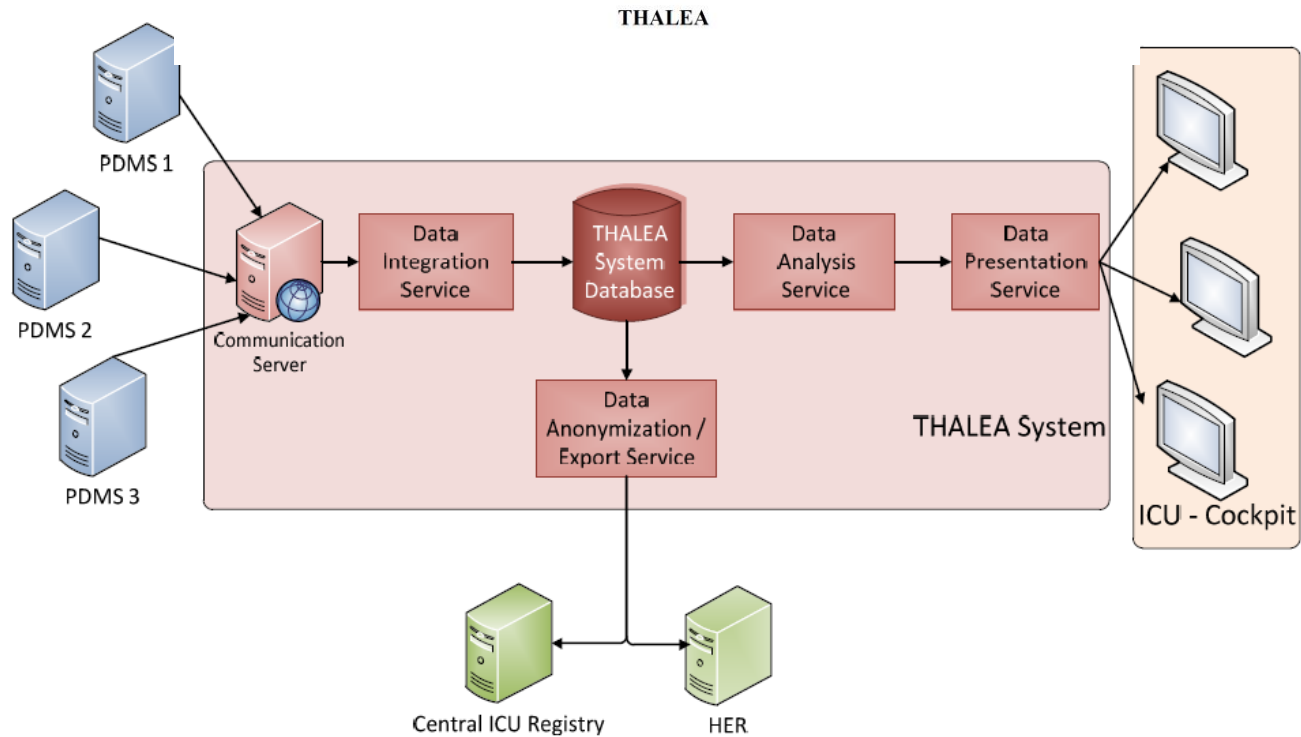

PCP process

1. Prior information notice
2. Open market consultation
3. PCP-Workshops
4. Review of tender documents by EU
5. Processing of Commission's advice and feedback
6. Launch of call for tender
7. Selection of five winning tenders
8. Development and evaluation of products during three phases



Open market consultation II

- Results
 - 23 interested companies from 5 different countries
 - 52% are e-specified companies
 - 25% are PDMS manufacturers
 - 82% of companies are familiar with data-safety and security
 - Strong interest in forming of consortia
